JEPPE HIGH SCHOOL FOR BOYS BUS SERVICE POLICY – 2022

This policy covers the rules, regulations and payment requirements for the morning and afternoon bus transport service between Jeppe High School for Boys and Alberton/Jhb South, Benoni and Edenvale areas.

- ✓ Payment is determined on an annual basis, as set out for each route specified, and is payable monthly in advance in 10 monthly instalments from February to November 2022.
- ✓ The parent/guardian of the learner is responsible for the full annual payment which must be up to date each month. Should the fees not be paid up to date, the learner will not be permitted on the bus.
- ✓ One month's written notice is required in respect of the cancellation of the service.
- ✓ On cancellation, should there be a credit due on the bus fees paid, these fees will be transferred to the school fee account of the learner.
- ✓ Use of any of the bus services is on the proviso that school fees are paid up to date.
- ✓ Bus fees are not covered by any bursary or scholarship whatsoever unless specifically included by the Scholarship Committee.
- ✓ Learners on exemption do not qualify for the bus service.
- ✓ There will be no deviation from the cost for 5 days per week for two trips per day.
- ✓ Unless specifically stated and arranged by the school, there will be no deviation from the route or times as set out below in respect of each of the bus services.
- ✓ It is the responsibility of the parents and learners to be at the designated collection and drop-off points at the correct time: -
 - Edenvale Service : collection at 6.45am from the Van Riebeeck Mall
 - Alberton/Johannesburg South Service : collection at 6.30am from the Meyersdal Mall
 - Benoni Service : collection at 6.30am from the Farramere Square
 - Jeppe High School for Boys : depart at 5.15pm from the road between the pool and Sable Boarding House
- ✓ The parent/guardian will become responsible for the transport arrangements for the learner should the learner not be able to make the bus at the designated time.
- ✓ Any bad behaviour on the bus will result in immediate exclusion from the service as well as the learner being subject to school disciplinary measures.
- ✓ Any learner found damaging the bus in any way whatsoever will immediately be excluded from the service, the parent/guardian will be responsible for the cost of the repairs as well as the learner being subject to school disciplinary measures.
- ✓ Any learner in school uniform or in any way being identified as a learner from Jeppe High School for Boys, found misbehaving in the areas in and around the collection and drop-off points, will immediately be excluded from the service as well as the learner being subject to school disciplinary measures.
- ✓ Any misdemeanour by a learner in terms of the School Code of Conduct will jeopardise the acceptance or accommodation of that learner on the bus.
- ✓ Jeppe High School for Boys reserves the right to exclude any learner from any of the bus services for whatever reason the school may deem fit and just.
- ✓ All learners are to adhere to the Covid-19 regulations as instituted by the school and the government for the duration of the pandemic. Sanitising and wearing of masks at all times is mandatory.
